Future ACES Scholarship - Herbert H. Carnegie Future Aces Foundation

The Herbert H. Carnegie Future Aces Foundation's National Citizenship Award and Scholarship Program provides merit-based scholarships to secondary students across Canada who exhibit exemplary citizenship qualities in their communities through extensive community service, volunteerism and humanitarian causes.

Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarship - Horatio Alger Association of Canada

The Canadian scholarships are awarded to deserving high school students in financial need who have overcome significant adversity. They must also demonstrate strength of character, strong academics, a commitment to pursuing higher education as well as a desire to contribute to society.

Niagara Catholic Student Senate Award - Niagara Catholic District School Board

Given to two NCDSB graduates who exemplify the values of a Catholic graduate as well as participation and excellence in academics, athletics, community, catholic involvement along with extra-curriculars.

Kiwanis Memorial Scholarship - Kiwanis Club of St. Catharines

Presented to one graduating student from each high school in St. Catharines. Each recipient must be pursuing post-secondary studies and have demonstrated strong academic abilities and commitment to extra-curricular activities. In recognition of ones achievement and dedication to excellence in education.

President's Scholarship of Distinction - University of Waterloo

Awarded to incoming students who has a high school who has a 95+ high school average, and I received an additional University of Waterloo Entrance Bursary, awarded in exceptional cases to students who have received this award.

Branscombe Family Foundation Scholarship - The Branscombe Family Foundation

Recipients are picked based primarily on financial need combined with academic excellence. Available to graduates of publicly-funded secondary schools in the Niagara Region.

Ontario English Catholic Teachers of Niagara Award - Ontario English Catholic Teachers' Association

This award is given to a student who has shown outstanding academic ability and community involvement. This student has been a graduate of a Catholic elementary school.

Canadian Italian Business and Professional Association of Niagara Education Award - The Canadian Italian Business & Professional Association of Niagara

The CIBPA Education Award Program is open to full-time college and/or university students at the undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate levels who are Canadian citizens or Landed Immigrants permanently residing in Canada, and who are of Italian origin.

Valedictorian – Selected in a vote by students from a candidate pool of the top 5 students with regards to their cumulative average

Governor General's Academic Award – Given to the student with the top average in grades 11 and 12

Principal's Award – Principal's choice of an ideal Catholic graduate

Saint Francis Leadership Award – Teacher's choice of a leader in the school community

Subject Proficiency - Math University – Teacher's choice of the most proficient student in the specified subject

Specialist High Skills Major – Environment – Earned by completing a series of school courses, certifications, and additional activities

School Letter – Given to students with an 80%+ average in all four years
